A new Dutch programme on research and knowledge transfer

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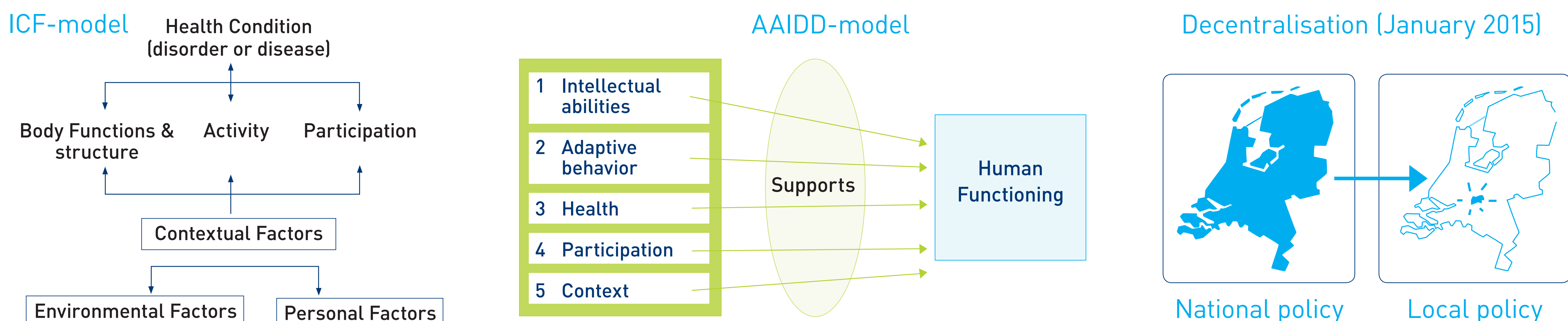

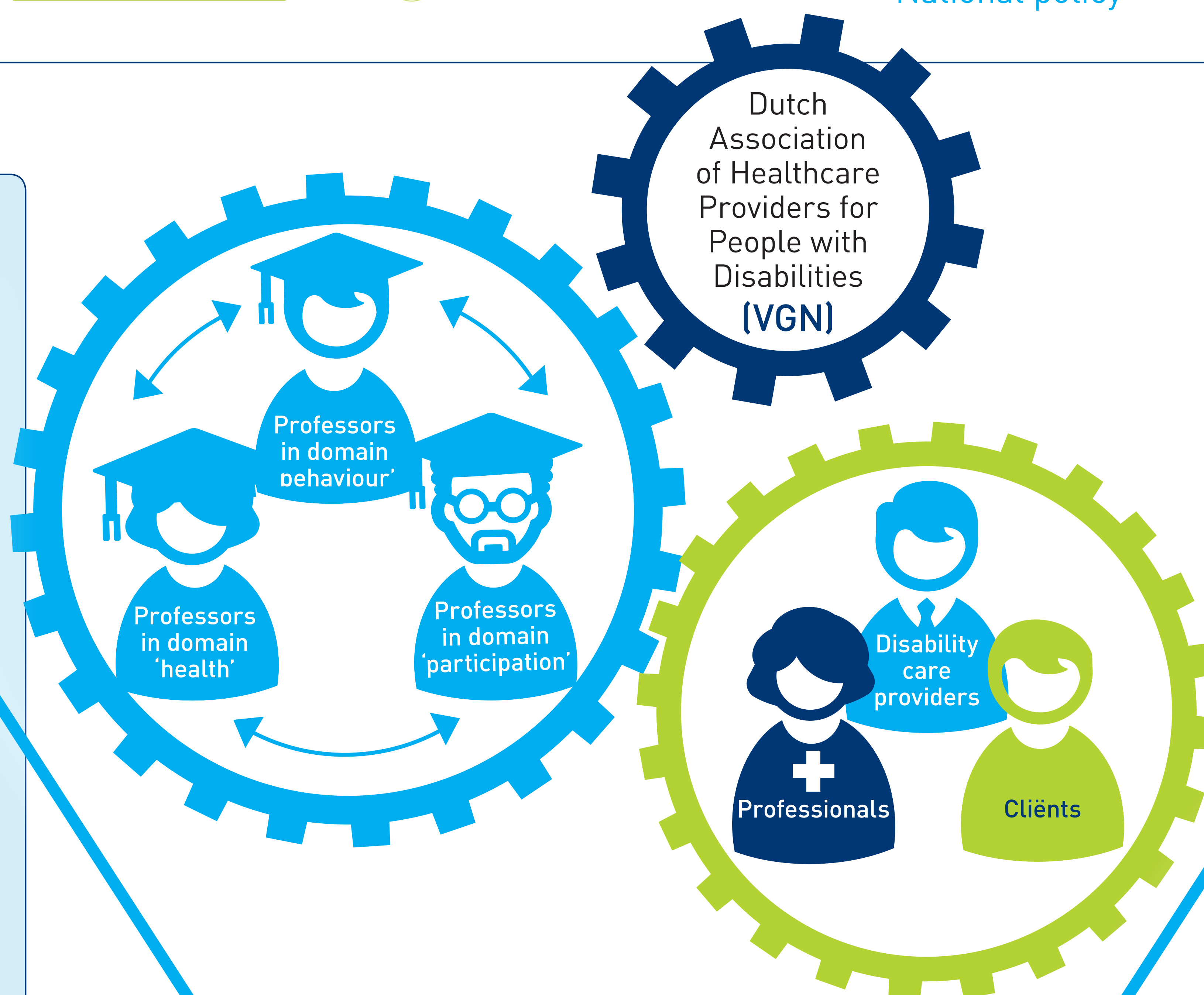
research institutes and care organizations of sciences related to health, participation and behaviour. It had produced the building blocks for a new programme in which knowledge development, knowledge distribution and implementation will take place.

Context



Process

- 1 The academic leaders developed recommendations for new research in the domains of health, behaviour and participation each for their own domain.
- 2 The academic leaders gave comments to each other's recommendations and consensus was reached.
- 3 In consultation meetings the support of clients, professionals and disability care providers has been assessed.
- 4 The final text was established and has been offered to the Dutch ministry of Health.
